AiM's current and past Boards had wisely decided to avoid this complication to our club's financial affairs.

The news and photo content that was formerly the front part of the newsletter can now be found on the website in the "News" tab, and I encourage you as members, to continue as our "news reporters". Your articles and reports are welcome; I encourage you to submit content to me at <u>hoodshowmanager@gmail.com</u> or to Holly and we'll do our best to get it published on the website.

The Shows and Events information is now on the "Events" tab of the website.

For my part, my favorite "reporter" activity is to scan every issue of the USEF, USDF, AHA and other horse magazines for AiM members and their achievements, and give them recognition in our Newsletters. Don't let me miss anyone! If you don't see your Award mentioned on our News page, let me know.
