These are not recognized classes for the Arabian Horse Association, and no apply. These classes DO NOT COUNT toward any AHA qualifications. There is a separate entry blank for these classes.



Thoroughbred Exhibitors Association (TBEA) Club Classes

This show is recognized as a Club show by the Thoroughbred Exhibitors Association (TBEA). TBEA members enter Opportunity - All Breeds classes and indicate their TBEA Membership on the entry form. Volunteer service at this show counts toward TBEA members' annual volunteer hours requirement. Arabian Horse Association Classes by Section (See specific entry form for these classes):

Sport Horse In-Hand For rules pertaining to Arabian Sport Horses, refer to USEF Rule Book, Arabian division, subchapter AR-13. In-Hand classes will be held on the triangle. Classes with the same AHA code and fewer than 4 entries may be combined. Download individual score sheets from: http://www.arabianhorses.org/competitions/managementforms.asp

Final order of class go and list of entries in each class will be posted at the show office and in-gate 1 hour before the start of the session. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to promptly present themselves when the gate person calls for their class. PA announcements, if made, are only a courtesy. Order of go for the class may be altered by the gate person in consideration of handlers presenting multiple horses. ② When everyone at the gate has shown, the class will be closed. Exhibitors on the roster who have not checked in will be recorded as No Shows.

Hunter Seat Equitation For rules pertaining to Arabian Hunter classes, refer to USEF Rule Book, Arabian division, subchapter AR-10; for Hunter Seat Equitation, subchapter AR-24 (AR 214 and 215). Hunter - Open hunter classes are judged on performance, manners and soundness, in that order. Junior and amateur classes are judged on manners, performance and soundness. Protective headgear - It is compulsory for all riders in hunter and hunter seat equitation classes, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) / SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. All juniors riding in hunter and hunter seat equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitted protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

Sport Horse Under Saddle & Show Hack For rules pertaining to Arabian Sport Horses, refer to USEF Rule Book, Arabian division, subchapter AR-13.

Dressage and Dressage Seat Equitation If you are entering an Arabian Dressage classes (other than Western – see Western Dressage Chapter WD) these classes are conducted in accordance with Dressage Chapter DR, except for exemptions listed in AR 156. If you are entering a dressage class, please familiarize yourself with both the Arabian and Dressage chapters of the USEF Rule Book, paying particular attention to AR 156 (Dressage subchapter), DR 120 (Dress) and 121 (Saddlery and Equipment). DRESSAGE SCHOOLING AREAS WILL BE MONITORED FOR COMPLIANCE.

If you are entering an Opportunity - All Breeds dressage class, the Dressage chapters of the USEF rulebook will apply.

TBA Classes

TBA (To be announced) classes are your opportunity to add an AHA class that you would like to compete in but do not see in the schedule. All TBA classes are subject to review and approval by the show committee. In order to hold a TBA class there must be one entry plus one class sponsorship. TBA Sponsorship Fees are \$60 per class. Payment for the TBA class sponsorship must be submitted immediately after the class has been approved. Only the TBA classes with class numbers assigned in the above class listing are available. No others will be added.

Classes must be chosen from the AHA class Code List. (See the AHA web site.) Any Class on the AHA Class List or that is recognized by AHA in the Dressage, Working Hunter or Sport Horse Sections – see below. All other AHA classes are excluded. TBA classes will be scheduled in the session/time when they best fit. Requests can be made but will not be guaranteed. Final schedule will be posted at the show office. You cannot duplicate any class already offered at this show.

Membership Requirements for Arabian Classes

Amateur Certification- Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday as of December 1, 2015 and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation. Forms may be obtained from the Federation. Certification will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur certification. There is no fee for amateur certification for Senior Active or Life Members

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded Owner and all Trainers, Drivers, Riders, Halter Handlers, Coaches and the Person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into the Competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA Membership/Competition Card, join AHA or pay an AHA Single Event membership fee per competitor. This does not apply to opportunity classes.

Volunteer Fee

Each Rider or Handler will be required to pay a Volunteer Fee of \$30, which will be waived it at least 2 hours of volunteer service is performed.

About the Facility

There are two arenas. The indoor (warm up) is 80X200 and the outdoor is 100X200. The footing is sand and soft rubber. There is also food for purchase on the grounds. No dogs are allowed on the grounds.

Stabling

There are 40 12X12 stalls available for day and overnight. 2 Bags of shavings are included with every overnight stall reservation. An exhibitor may bring their own extra shavings. There are no tack stalls. There is an area for trailer parking in front of the stall area. Management reserves the right to assign stalls according to certain criteria. First priority will be Silver Sponsors. Other consideration will be distance horses have traveled as well as other criteria. Horses spending the entire weekend at the show will have priority. In case the request for stalls is greater then what is available; there will be a list of alternative locations for stabling. Silver sponsorship is \$75 and in addition to stall fees. See sheet.

Show Hours

Horses will be allowed on the grounds at 3 PM on Friday July 24, 2021. Schooling will be available until 9 PM on both Friday July 24 and Saturday July 25. The office will be open from one hour before the first class until after the last class of day.

Lodging

Cancellation and Refunds

Exhibitors who cancel entries prior to July 15, 2021 will receive a full refund, less Office fee. Exhibitors cancelling after July 15, 2021 will forfeit all class and stabling fees except in the case of disability of entry. Should an entry be unable to compete due to illness or injury, a doctor or veterinary statement (on official letterhead), must be received by the show secretary prior to 6PM July 24, 2021. Such refund will include all fees less a \$50 cancellation fee. After 6PM July 24, no refunds will be made. In the event of a show cancellation due to severe weather or other emergency, refunds of entry fees will be made upon written request by the exhibitor within 30 days of the cancellation.

Change fee

Any change of rider, handler or class (subject to availability) may be made for a \$5 fee.

Returned Checks

Checks returned by the bank for any reason will incur a \$50 charge per domestic check (\$75 per International check). No checks will be processed through the bank a second time. To retain entries, fees plus penalty must be paid by money order, cashier's check or cash within 7 days of notification or post entries will be applied to your entry. Show packets will not be released until all debts are settled. In the event a check is returned by the bank after the completion of the show, it will be handled in accordance with USEF GR913. Entries will be refused from exhibitors with outstanding obligations to any Region 4 AHA affiliated club or show. (R4 BOD directive)
