Carriage Pleasure Driving classes held in the Arabian Division are to be conducted in accordance with Carriage Pleasure Driving Division, Chapter CP. If a class title does not list Arabian, Half Arabian or Anglo Arabian in the class title, it is open to all three breeds.

Dressage

This competition is recognized by USEF as an Arabian division competition. Note that AR156 provides that Dressage classes held in the Arabian Division will be conducted in accordance with Dressage Chapter DR, except for the exemptions listed as DR156.1-12. If you are entering a dressage class, please familiarize yourself with both the Arabian and Dressage chapters of the USEF Rule Book.

• DRESSAGE RIDE TIMES •

Dressage classes will not be held in the order published in the prize list, however short court classes will be held at the beginning of the Friday and Saturday morning sessions. Tentative ride times will be posted at www.arabiansinmotion.org by April 15th. Updates will be posted as changes occur, so please check back often. Final ride times will be posted on the website by noon the day before the competition and available at the show office. DR126.1.b (3) forbids change of dressage ride times once final times have been posted. Therefore, please check your times as soon as they are available online, and report conflicts to the show secretary immediately. If you wait until you get to the show, we won't be able to help you. Responsibility for obtaining ride times remains with the competitor.

Safety Rules for drivers. . .

- ☑ SAFETY IS OUR NUMBER ONE CONCERN.
- ☑ ALL DRIVERS ARE INVITED TO ATTEND A "WHIP" MEETING.
- ☑ HORSES MAY NEVER BE LEFT UNATTENDED WHILE HITCHED TO A VEHICLE.
- ☑ LINES MUST BE ATTACHED TO BIT BEFORE HITCHING HORSE TO VEHICLE.
- ☑ NO HORSE MAY BE TIED WHILE HITCHED.
- ☑ UNDER no condition may a bridle be removed while horse is still hitched to a vehicle.
- ☑ NEVER leave the ends of the reins unbuckled while getting into the vehicle or while driving.
- ☑ MAKE sure that your vehicle and harness are in good repair and sound.
- ☑ COMMUNICATE with people in other vehicles. Let them know you are coming up behind them or wish to pass them.
TALK TO THEM
- ☑ WHIPS (Drivers) must maintain a safe distance (at least equal to the length of their equine and rig) from other vehicles at all times, including the competition arena, the warm up area, parking lots, etc.
- ☑ WHIPS (Drivers) should always be the first person to enter and the last person to leave the vehicle.
- ☑ ANYONE riding in a vehicle must have signed a release form in the office first.

Dressage CONTINUED

Dressage Court Size ● Classes 101-104 & 201-203 will be held in a short court (20m x 40m) with entry at A. All other tests, including Test of Choice classes and all musical rides, will be held in a standard court (20mx60m), with entry from inside the arena. Entries in these classes will enter the court and begin schooling as soon as the previous rider has saluted (unless there is an intervening break). When the judge signals that time has started, rider will not exit the court; rather, begin the test by proceeding to A and turning down the centerline.

Dressage scratches and 'no shows' ● If you don't show up for an assigned ride time, this Competition reserves the right to scratch you from all remaining dressage rides and offer them to other exhibitors. If you are unable or choose not to ride, you must notify the show secretary immediately. It is the rider's responsibility to make sure that notification is received by the show secretary - a message left on an answering machine or e-mail sent after she has left for the competition may not protect your remaining rides. *We recommend that you make sure you receive a verbal or written acknowledgement of your scratch.* [USEF rule DR126.1.b (3)]

Dressage Musical Freestyle Qualification ● "...in order to enter a freestyle class at any level, a horse/rider combination must have received a score of 60% in the highest test of the declared freestyle level or any test of a higher level at a Federation Licensed Competition held prior to the competition where the horse/rider combination is entered to ride a freestyle class. A photocopy of the test verifying eligibility must be submitted with the entry for a freestyle class." [USEF rule DR128.9]

Dressage Musical Rides ● Sound checks will be scheduled and posted with ride times. Exhibitors are responsible for delivering their music on CD to the announcer's booth before their sound check. Each exhibitor/team must also provide a person to assist the announcer during sound check and competition.

Dressage Novice Horse classes ● are open to horses that have not won three first place ribbons at Regular Member or Dressage competitions rated by USEF or Equine Canada in the particular performance section or level in which they are showing. See USEF GR134 for complete details.

Dressage Walk/Trot for Riders 11 & Older ● Classes 101 and 102, Introductory Dressage (walk/trot) for riders 11 and older, will be held only if space is available at closing date. All entries will be processed in postmark order, with entries in classes 101 and 102 wait listed. Once all entries postmarked by closing date have been processed, if no ride times remain, these classes will be cancelled, and these class fees refunded. If ride times *are* available, entries in classes 101 and 102 will be admitted in postmark order.

Hunter, Jumper, and Hunter Seat Equitation

For rules pertaining to Arabian Hunter classes, refer to USEF Rule Book, Arabian division, subchapter AR-10; for Jumpers AR-11, and for Hunter Seat Equitation chapter AR-24 (AR 214 and 215).

Hunter ● Open hunter classes are judged on performance, manners and soundness, in that order. Junior and amateur classes are judged on manners, performance and soundness.

Jumper ● classes scored Table II Sec. 2b. Ties for other than first place shall remain tied and riders will flip a coin for ribbons. Jump order will be drawn. Time allowed is based on minimum speed of 360 yards per minute.

Hunter schooling rounds ● will be available Sunday afternoon for \$10 each, at approximately 3 minutes each. Sign up on your entry form or you may pay at the gate. Fence heights start at 2 ft., and will be over the type of fences used for competition. Sign up in the paddock for your desired fence height. Only horses entered in over fence classes will be allowed to school.

Protective headgear ● It is compulsory for all riders in hunter, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials) / SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. All juniors riding in hunter, jumper and hunter seat equitation sections, while riding anywhere on the competition grounds, must wear properly fitted protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place.

AHA Hunter Seat Not to Jump Medal Class ● Open to junior riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to Dec. 1, 2009. In addition to the rail work, all contestants are required to perform two or more individual tests from USEF AR217 1-4 & sub chapter 2 (EQ113).

AHA Hunter Seat Over Obstacles Medal Class ● Open to junior riders who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to Dec. 1, 2009. For a medal to be awarded three (3) competitors with proper appointments must compete. If fewer than three, then points will be earned. To be shown over a course of not fewer than six obstacles with fence heights of 2'6" to 3'; which must include an oxer and two changes of direction (changes of lead). (Res. 53-96) Two or more tests of the top four contestants are required from USEF Tests 1-7, 9-15, 17-19 or EC equivalent. One rider per horse.

AHA Medal classes with pattern ● will be held regardless of number of competitors. An AHA Medal class must have a minimum of three (3) competitors with proper appointments in order to have an AHA Medal awarded. For AHA Medal classes with fewer than three (3) competitors, AHA Medal points will be earned. (Refer to AHA Article 1357).

Crossrail Equitation over fences ● **Crossrail Hunter** To be shown and judged as a Hunter Seat Equitation Over Fences and Hunter class respectively consisting of a course of 8 fences in crossrail formation set at a height of 1'6" - 2'0". Simple changes of lead and trotting not to be penalized. No additional testing.

Sport Horse In-Hand

For rules pertaining to Arabian Sport Horses, refer to USEF Rule Book, Arabian division, subchapter AR-13. In-Hand classes will be held on the triangle. Classes with the same AHA code and fewer than 4 entries may be combined. Score Sheets may be downloaded from this link: <http://www.arabianhorses.org/competitions/managementforms.asp>

- In-hand classes will not necessarily run in the order printed in the prize list. Tentative class order and entry order of go will be posted at www.arabiansinmotion.org on April 15th.
- Final order of class go and list of entries in each class will be posted at the show office and in-gate 1 hour before the start of the session.
- It is the exhibitors' responsibility to follow how quickly classes are progressing and to promptly present themselves when the gate person calls for their class. PA announcements, if made, are only a courtesy. Order of go for the class will be determined by the gate person with consideration to handlers presenting multiple horses.
- When everyone at the gate has shown, the class will be closed. Exhibitors on the roster who have not checked in will be recorded as No Shows.
- Scorers will be at arena-side scoring in real time. As one horse leaves the ring, the score for the previous horse will be announced and posted at the gate. Exhibitors who are not in the ribbons are free to leave.
- Awards will be presented **in the arena** following each class. Please be ready to reenter the arena as soon as the last horse in the class is done. Don't forget to pick up your score sheet afterward at the show office.
- Champion and Reserve Champions will be determined by score, and will be presented at the end of each division. For example, the top scoring horse from classes 118 and 119 will be named Champion Stallion, with the second high score named Reserve Champion. **Note:** In sport horse classes, champions and reserves must be at least 2 years of age. Time is limited. In fairness to other competitors, if you are not at the in-gate when your championship is announced, we will assume that you have chosen not to take advantage of this opportunity for recognition.

Your promptness and cooperation in keeping the show running smoothly is sincerely appreciated!

Get of Sire ● 2-3 offspring of one sire shown without sire. All offspring must have been judged in individual in-hand classes at this competition. See USEF Rule AR161.3 and the AHA Sport Horse In-Hand Group Score Sheet for class conduct and judging criteria.

Produce of Dam ● 2-3 offspring of one dam shown without dam. All offspring must have been judged in individual in-hand classes at this competition. See USEF Rule AR161.3 and the AHA Sport Horse In-Hand Group Score Sheet for class conduct and judging criteria.

Breeder's Group ● 2-3 horses of any age or sex, all bred by exhibitor. Horses need not have been judged in individual in-hand classes, but each horse in the group must be individually entered according to the entry requirements of this competition. Conduct of Class to follow AR161.3; to be judged using the AHA Sport Horse In-Hand Group Score Sheet.

Dam Line Group ● 3 horses related as follows:

- Mother, daughter and daughter's offspring (any age or gender) or
- Mother and two offspring or
- Three offspring, mother deceased (Copy of death certificate or AHA registration stating "Deceased" required.)

Horses need not have been judged in individual in-hand classes, but each horse in the group must be individually entered according to the entry requirements of this competition. The group will enter the ring in birth order, oldest to youngest. Conduct of Class to follow AR161.3; to be judged 50% on overall family quality, using the AHA Group Score Sheet, and 50% on improvement in successive breeding.
