Next AiM Meeting: Saturday, June 9, 1:00 p.m. at Para Hevea Equine Facility, Mollala Oregon. Working Western Demonstration

There will be a demonstration of cattle cutting and other working cattle classes, and discussion of other working western classes, such as reining and trail. Connie Schmidt Walling and her husband Ken, who is a professional cutting-horse trainer, will put on the clinic. Both are members of the Arabian Cutting Horse Club and would like to see an AHA-sponsored Working Western Show. After the demonstration, there will be a social hour with refreshments. If you are staying for this, please bring a light appetizer. **NOTE: Because there is a fee for use of the arena, there will be a \$15 charge to attend this event.**

- Take **I-5 to Exit 271** at Woodburn. Turn heading **east** at the exit ramp light.
- Continue on **Hwy 211** heading **east**. Travel east on Hwy 211 for approximately **9.3 miles** until you reach the intersection of Kropf Rd. and Hwy 211.
- **Turn right** on to **Kropf Rd.** travel approximately **0.9 miles** (just past the Yoder Store) to S. Schneider Rd.
- **Turn left** on to **S. Schneider Rd.** and travel approximately **0.7 miles**. There will be a **Para-Hevea** sign on the right just past the big red barn and a light gray house with white trim.
- **Turn right** on to the asphalt drive. At this point you will see the event arena.

Directions from I-205

- Exit **I-205, Cascade Hwy S, OR-213, East Portland Fwy** via ramp at sign reading "Exit 10 OR-213 to Park Place / Molalla" and go **Southwest** for **0.2 miles**

- Bear right on **OR-213, Cascade Hwy S** and go **South** for **16.4 miles**
- Turn right on **OR-211, Woodburn-Estacada Hwy, S OR-211** and go **West** for **2.2 miles**
- Turn left on **S Dryland Rd** and go **South** for **0.9 miles**
- Turn right on **S Schneider Rd** and go **West** for **0.6 miles** to **9936 S Schneider Rd**
